Notes to the Unaudited Consolidated Financial Results:

- 1 Dhani Services Limited ('Holding Company') and its subsidiaries are together referred to as 'the Group' in the following notes. These unaudited consolidated financial results of the Group have been prepared in accordance with Indian Accounting Standards ("Ind AS") notified under Section 133 of the Companies Act 2013 ("the Act") read with the Companies (Indian Accounting Standards) Rules, 2015 as amended by the Companies Indian Accounting Standards (Amendment) Rules, 2016 and the requirements of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 (as amended).
- 2 These unaudited consolidated financial results of the Group have been reviewed by the Audit Committee and subsequently approved at the meeting of the Board of Directors held on 10 February 2023. These unaudited consolidated financial results have been subjected to limited review by the statutory auditors of the Company.
- India is emerging from the COVID-19 virus, a global pandemic that affected the world economy over the last two years. The extent to which any new wave of COVID-19 will impact the Company's results will depend on ongoing as well as future developments, including, among other things, any new information concerning the severity of the COVID-19 pandemic, and any action to contain its spread or mitigate its impact whether government-mandated or elected by us. The Company has recognized provisions as on 31 December 2022 towards its loan assets, based on the information available at this point of time, in accordance with the expected credit loss method. The Company believes that it has considered all the possible impact of the known events arising out of COVID-19 pandemic in the preparation of financial results. However, the impact assessment of COVID-19 is a continuing process given its nature and duration. The Company will continue to monitor any material changes to future economic condition. The Company's capital and liquidity position remains sufficient and would continue to be the focus area for the Company; accordingly, the Company does not expect a stress on its liquidity situation in the immediate future.
- 4 The Holding Company was carrying on the business of stock broking which was demerged during the financial year 2019-20. Accordingly, as at and during the year ended 31 March 2022 and period ended 31 December 2022, the financial assets of the Holding Company were more than fifty percent of its total assets and income from financial assets was more than fifty percent of the gross income. The Holding Company's present business activities consists of providing loans and making investments in group companies, consequentially, the Holding Company may be required to apply and obtain the Certificate of Registration (CoR) from Reserve Bank of India (RBI) as a Non-Banking Financial Company (NBFC) under the category (OCP). The management is of the view that basis of their present business operations and financials, the Holding Company qualifies to fall under the category of an unregistered CIC and has written to RBI for their views in this regard, response to which is still awaited. The management is also of the view that the possible non-compliance with such requirement is not expected to have a material impact on the accompanying financial results.



- 5 During the quarter ended June 30, 2022, the Company has utilised/applied an amount of Rs. 72,961.20 lakhs (net of deferred tax) from the outstanding balance in the securities premium account for creating a provision for impairment losses on financial instruments of Dhani Loans and Services Limited ("DLSL") which is a 100% subsidiary of Dhani Services Limited "DSL", instead of debiting the same to the Standalone Statement of Profit and Loss, which is not in strict accordance with the applicable provisions of Indian Accounting Standards and other applicable regulations. The Reserve Bank of Indian had issued a communication to the Industry dated June 20, 2022 which impacts one of the DLSL's products/services offered to its customers. Consequently, the Company, on a conservative basis, has created the above mentioned provision in respect of any future, unanticipated losses which may arise on account of the impact of the above RBI communication. Further, Dhani Loans and Services Limited has sold loans to IARCL which is a 100% subsidiary of DSL. However, the recoveries from the pool of loans sold to IARCL will accrue in IARCL and ultimately to the benefit of DSL in consolidated financials as IARCL is 100% subsidiary of DSL.
- 6 During the nine month ended 31 December 2022, the Bond Issue Committee of the Board of Directors of the Dhani Loans and Services Limited (Wholly owned subsidiary of the DSL) in its meeting held on 17th May 2022 approved and allotted 957,648 NCDs of face value of ₹1,000 each, aggregating to ₹ 9,576.48 Lakhs on public issue basis.
